This is a national classification swim meet that is associated with the Paralympic Division of the United States Olympic Committee but international participants will also be in attendance. All swimmers with a disability are welcome. Seating is based upon time regardless of classification and all swimmers compete together in each event.

This long course meters competition will be governed by the most recent International Paralympic Committee Swimming technical rules. The meet will consist of three timed finals sessions. Event begins at 8am Saturday and goes through Sunday mid afternoon. Parking is available at the Woodside Garage on UC Campus.
