CINCINNATI (March 3, 2011)

The 2011 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship first and second round games will be held at Xavier University. The first round games played on Sunday, March 20 will be at noon and 2:30 p.m. The second round game on Tuesday, March 22 will be played at 7 p.m. All games will be played at Cintas Center.

The 64 teams making up the 2011 championship field will be announced on Selection Monday, March 14 at 7 p.m. EST on ESPN. Xavier will play at Cintas Center.

Tickets are currently on sale. All-session tickets are \$27 for adults and \$17 for youth (17 and under). Group tickets at a discounted rate are also on sale for groups of 15 or more. A Family Four Pack is also being offered that includes four single session tickets, four hot dogs and four sodas for just \$55 and can only be purchased on game day at the Xavier Athletic Ticket Office.
